

SeaBus, three passenger-only ferries linking Downtown Vancouver and North Vancouver



Cycling

Contributions to new bike paths and locker facilities (≈ 1,000 km of existing bike paths)



HandyDART

A custom transit service for people with disabilities, there are 310 vehicles in the fleet

Commuter Rail Services
West Coast Express operates five



Regional Context: Population Surrounding Rapid Transit: 2045 (est.)






Current Real Estate Activity on TransLink's Rapid Transit Network: 50+ Projects






Sustainable transportation in Metro Vancouver is a success story

TransLink has nearly doubled transitionidership since 1999






The 10-Year Vision is TransLink's blueprint for transportation investment

The 23-member Mayors' Council developed the 10-Year Vision in 2014, with guidance from the Regional Growth Strategy and Regional Transportation Strategy.


The TransLink Board has endorsed the 10-Year Vision as the blueprint for TransLink investments.








Pattullo Bridge Replacement

- Pattullo Bridge was built in 1937 and designed for a 50-year life
- A critical connection for people, services, and goods in the region







Pattullo Bridge Replacement

Replace the existing and aging Pattullo Bridge with a new four-lane tolled bridge, as identified in the 10-Year Vision.

Work authorized to "procurement readiness" including:

- Project definition
- Business case
- Environmental assessment
- Third party agreements
- Strategic property acquisitions
- Draft RFQ, RFP, and project agreement
